AccuMic Discontinuation and Last Time Buy

November 11, 2009

This notice is to inform our customers and partners of ClearOne's intentions to discontinue the AccuMic line of conferencing microphones. This notice is effective immediately and a Last Time Buy program will be implemented. The CHAT 150 and CHAT 160 are suggested replacements for the AccuMic.

As part of the Last Time Buy program, purchase orders for AccuMic will be accepted through the end of July, 2010, or until product inventories are depleted. After inventories are depleted, no further AccuMic orders will be accepted.

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FAQ

Q: Why is ClearOne discontinuing the AccuMic line of microphones?

A: ClearOne designed and introduced the CHAT 150 over two years ago as a less expensive replacement for the AccuMic products. Since then, AccuMic demand has steadily decreased. Additionally, some of the parts used in AccuMic production have become obsolete.

Q: What is the last day that orders will be taken for AccuMic?

A: We will take AccuMic orders until our current part inventories are depleted, which is currently estimated to be July 2010.

Q: Will ClearOne continue to provide support and repair for AccuMic?

A: Of course. Even after ClearOne ships the last AccuMic, we will continue to provide support for the product.

Q: Can AccuMic interoperate with the newer CHAT 150 in order to expand an existing installation?

A: No, the two product lines are not designed to interoperate.

Q: What are the major differences between the AccuMic and the CHAT 150 or CHAT 160?

A: The biggest difference is that the CHAT 150 (as well as the CHAT 160 and CHAT 170) has three microphones and a large speaker and is priced lower than the AccuMic. Also, the PC version of the CHAT 150 connects to PCs and laptops via USB. For many customers, the fact that the CHAT 150 has microphones as well as a speaker will be a big advantage.
