

Running XAP Net Web Server Interface with Java 1.5.0

The web browser locks up when accessing web interface functions in XAP Net when using Java 1.5.0.

Problem Description

An issue has been identified with the latest release of Sun's Java software version 1.5.0 (also called version 5). The browser connects to the XAP Net web server interface, but fails moments later. The result is that the XAP Net interface indicates a loss of connection and the browser locks up and will not respond to any button clicks, which requires the user to use the Windows task manager to end the process.

This has been determined to be a JavaScript handling error in Sun's latest release. Sun is aware of the issue, but it is unknown whether they will fix the error. Previous versions of Java do not exhibit this issue.

Resolution

The XAP Net web interface is compatible with Java version 1.4.2 and earlier, which is available from Sun for download at <http://java.sun.com/j2se/1.4.2/download.html>.

The version available to download and install on your PC is J2SE v 1.4.2_07 JRE, which includes the JVM technology.

Uninstall Java 1.5 and then install version 1.4.2 to ensure proper functioning of the XAP Net web interface.
