RAV 600/900 & CONVERGE 560/590 UPDATE

ClearOne announces the release of new firmware on the RAV 600/900 and Converge 560/590 product lines. The primary enhancements to the identified product line include:

- **Improved Acoustical Echo Cancellation Performance:** ClearOne has implemented its next generation AEC developed for the Converge Pro on the RAV 600/900 and Converge 560/590. Primary improvements are related to duplex performance.
- **Serial Control for PA Adapt on Converge 560/590:** A new serial command has been implemented on the Converge 560/590 to allow an integrator to enable or disable PA Adaptive Mode on the unit. The PA Adaptive mode can have adverse effects on gating performance in highly reverberant rooms. The default value in the firmware is PA Adaptive Mode is enabled. The command format is listed below.

» PAA - PA Adaptive Mode

This command selects/reports PA adaptive mode for the specified mic.
