CONVERGE Huddle's Acoustic Echo Cancellation can be applied in the following methods


1. Use the built in AEC of the CONVERGE Huddle with reference to one of the built in amplifier outputs.



The AEC will reference the speaker output 1 or speaker output 2. Aplification is built into the CONVERGE Huddle.

Speakers

2. Use the built in AEC of the CONVERGE Huddle with reference to one of the line outputs. You will use an external amplifier to drive speakers in this case.



The AEC will reference the Line Out 1 or Line Out 2.

External amplification required. (CONVERGE PA460 shown)

3. Use custom firmware from ClearOne to avail audio output from HDMI port to connect through TV speakers. In this case, the AEC from CONVERGE Huddle is disabled and users will depend on echo cancellation built into the software conferencing tools such as Zoom, MS Teams, etc.
